

# MODIFIED LIBERO TRACKING

## For HIGH SCHOOL

1. Enter Home and Visitor team (names) on the Tracking Sheet.
2. Next to L put the # of the Libero being used for that game.  
If no Libero is being used put an X after the L.
3. Enter in the "SP" column the starting players for each team.  
This should be an exact match of the lineup entry in the scorebook.
- \*4. When a Libero enters the game as a replacement, place a L and the # of the Libero next to the number of the player being replaced. L6  
  
\*\* Do NOT slash any Libero replacements, as this makes it more difficult to quickly identify the Libero replacement lines, as these blend in with the regular substitution lines of slashed numbers..
5. *Caution:* Only the same player's number in front of the "L " can be the number AFTER the Libero's number. The player the Libero came into the game for can be the only LEGAL Libero replacement. \*\* NOTIFY the Umpire (R2) IMMEDIATELY, BEFORE THE NEXT SERVE, if ANYTHING else occurs.
- \*6. When the Libero is replaced (again, by the SAME player) the returning player's number is placed AFTER the Libero L&#. The number on BOTH side of the Libero's L&#.
7. The Libero Tracker also records ALL substitutions. When a player (Not a Libero) is substituted out of the game, her / his number is slashed out and the player's number entering is written next to it on the line.
8. There are UNLIMITED Libero replacements.  
  
There are 18 regular substitutions per game.
9. Note: A different Libero can be designated for each game, but the designation MUST be made on the line-up sheet when it is submitted before the game.

Suggested: Coaches NOT using a Libero put an X where the Libero number goes on the line-up sheet.
